

## Rules & Conditions

All classes will be run in accordance with the latest BRC official rules.

All horses must have had at least their first two vaccinations, and not have had a vaccine within 7 days of the show. We run to 12 month vaccinations.

**Correctly** fitted hard hats to CURRENT recognised British standard must be worn & securely fastened when mounted, and strongly recommended for In Hand.

**Body** protectors are strongly recommended.

**In public areas** of the show ground horses/ponies must be ridden/led at walk.

**Please** respect the hospitality of the landowners & take your litter home/use bins provided.

**Do not clean out your horse box/trailer on the field.**

**No** refund of entry fees will be given.

**The** judge's decision is final & any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a £20 deposit, the deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.

**Dogs** must be kept on a short lead & under control at all times & all faeces picked up.

**Horses & ponies** must not be left unattended unless correctly secured inside the trailer/lorry.

**Age as of January 1st 2022.**

**Any** person riding on a lead rein must do so for the rest of the event.

**Non-members** riding a member's horse must pay non-members entry fees.

**No** horse/pony under 4 years of age can be ridden on the show ground.

**No** responsibility can be taken for theft, loss, damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

**All** persons attending must have their own 3<sup>rd</sup> party liability insurance.

**The** organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all official stewards.

**Maximum of 3 Jumping Classes to be entered.**

**Maximum of 4 entries per Horse/Pony for showing.**

**Maximum of 5 entries per Horse/Pony for each show day.**

**The making of an entry implies acceptance of the conditions above.**

**RoR** - Our Dressage and SJ classes will be RoR unaffiliated league qualifiers.

Members Points awarded to 6th place. Open to Horses & Ponies, rider any age.

Class 1 - 50cm including Lead Rein, Rosettes to all

Class 2 - 60cm including Lead Rein, Rosettes to all

Class 3 - 70cm

Class 4 - 80cm

Class 5 - 90cm

Class 6 - 100cm, Class 6 will only run if sufficient entries

## **In hand Showing** (from 10.30am)

Class 7 - Intro to Showing - For novices never to have won a showing class Walk only, Can be assisted

Class 8 - Best Turned Out - Will split junior/senior if sufficient entries

Class 9 - RoR - Horse must have raced/Been in training

Class 10 - Coloured - Including Appaloosa, Dun and Palomino

Class 11 - Cobs and Cob type

Class 12 - Mountain & Moorland - Will split Large & Small if sufficient entries

Class 13 - Veteran - Horses to be 15+ years

Class 14 - Best Mare/Gelding

**In hand Championship for classes 7 to 14 - 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from each class.**

## **Ridden Showing** (from 10.00am) Lead Rein allowed in all classes

Class 15 - Intro to Showing - For novices never to have won a showing class, no canter

Class 16 - Best Turned out - Will split junior/senior if sufficient entries

Class 17 - Mountain and Moorland - Will split Large & Small if sufficient entries

Class 18 - Best Mare/Gelding

Class 19 - Riding Club Horse/Pony - May be asked to jump a small fence – Will split Junior/Senior if sufficient entries

Class 20 - Coloured - Including Appaloosa, Dun and Palomino

Class 21 - RoR - Horses must have raced/Been in training

Class 22 - Veteran - Horses to be 15+ years

Class 23 - Cobs and Cob type

Class 24 - Foreign Breeds, All breeds not native to the UK

**Ridden Championship for classes 15 to 24 - 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from each class.**

## **Mini Show Jumping** (from 10.30am)

Combinations jumping in this ring may not jump in the main show jumping. Lead rein & assistance permitted in all classes, rosettes to all, no back rails

Class 25 - Poles on the floor

Class 26 - 10cm – ½ X poles

Class 27 - 20cm – X poles

Class 28 - 30cm

Class 29 - 40cm

## **Clear Round** (from 10am)

Entries on the gate, riders must have a number.

Heights to be adjusted to suit you, from poles on the floor to 70cm.

## **Dressage** (from 10.00am)

Warm up will be on grass with test on a surface.

Assistance/Lead rein permitted in Class 1 & 2.

Members Points awarded to 6th place in all classes.

We will be running a dressage championship at our September show for all combinations that place 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup>

Classes will run from Intro - Novice and if entries over the summer permit, Elementary.
