

Rules & Conditions

Maximum of 3 Jumping Classes to be entered

Maximum of 4 entries per Horse/Pony for showing

Maximum of 5 entries per Horse/Pony for each show day

Do not clean out your horse box/trailer on the field.

All classes will be run in accordance with the latest BRC official rules.

All horses must have had at least their first two vaccinations, and not have had a vaccine within 7 days of the show

Correctly fitted hard hats to CURRENT recognised British standard must be worn & securely fastened when mounted, And strongly recommended for In Hand

Body protectors are strongly recommended.

In public areas of the show ground horses/ponies must be ridden/led at walk.

Please respect the hospitality of the landowners & take your litter home/use bins provided.

No refund of entry fees will be given.

The judge's decision is final & any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a £20 deposit, the deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.

Dogs must be kept on a short lead & under control at all times & all faeces picked up

Horses & ponies must not be left unattended unless correctly secured inside the trailer/lorry.

Age as of January 1st 2023

Any person riding on a lead rein must do so for the rest of the event.

Non-members riding a member's horse must pay non-members entry fees.

No horse/pony under 4 years of age can be ridden on the show ground.

No responsibility can be taken for theft, loss, damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

All persons attending must have their own 3rd party liability insurance.

Photographs: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst at this event: these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed, please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you start your round.

The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. Class 1 - 50cm including Lead Rein, Rosettes to all

Class 2 - 60cm including Lead Rein, Rosettes to all

Class 3 - 70cm

Class 4 - 80cm

Class 5 - 90cm

We will run a class if sufficient entries. If not you are still welcome to jump

In hand Showing (from 10.30am)

Class 6 - Youngstock - For horses and ponies up to and including 3 years old

Class 7 - Coloured - Including Appaloosa, Dun and Palomino

Class 8 - Mountain & Moorland - Will split Large & Small if sufficient entries

Class 9 - RoR - Horse must have raced/Been in training

Class 10 - Veteran - Horses to be 15+ years

Class 11- Cobs and Cob type

Class 12 - Intro to Showing - For novices never to have won an in hand showing class. Walk only, Can be assisted. This applies to horse, rider & combination.

Class 13 - Best Turned Out - Will split junior/senior if sufficient entries.

Class 14 - Best Mare/Gelding

In hand Championship for classes 6 to 14 - 1st & 2nd from each class

Ridden Showing (from 10.00am)

Class 15 - Intro to Showing, Walk only- For novices never to have won a showing class. This applies to horse, rider & combination.

Class 16 - Intro to Showing, Walk & Trot - For novices never to have won a showing class. This applies to horse, rider & combination.

Class 17 - Under 12s Lead Rein

Class 18 - Under 12s First Ridden

Class 19 - Best Turned out - Will split junior/senior if sufficient entries

Class 20 - Mountain and Moorland - Will split Large & Small if sufficient entries

Class 20 - Best Mare/Gelding

Class 21 - Riding Club Horse/Pony - Will split Junior/Senior if sufficient entries

Class 22 - Coloured - Including Appaloosa, Dun and Palomino

Class 26 - Foreign Breeds, All breeds not native to the UK

Ridden Championship for classes 15 to 26 - 1st & 2nd from each class

Mini Show Jumping (from 10.30am)

Combinations jumping in this ring may not jump in the main showjumping. Lead rein & assistance permitted in all classes, Rosettes to all, No back rails

Class 27 - Poles on the floor

Class 28 - 10cm – ½ X poles

Class 29 - 20cm – X poles

Class 30 - 30cm

Class 31 - 40cm

Clear Round Riders must have paid First Aid & obtained a number. Payment to be made at secretaries. Rosettes to all

From 10.00-10.30 am in the mini jumping ring - £4 per round

From 10.30-11.00 am in the show jumping ring - £6 per round

Dressage (from 10.00am) **MUST PRE ENTER VIA OUR WEBSITE**

Warm up will be on grass with test on a surface

Assistance/Lead rein permitted in Class 1, 2 & 3.
