

Rules & Conditions

Maximum of 3 Jumping Classes to be entered

Maximum of 4 entries per Horse/Pony for showing

Maximum of 5 entries per Horse/Pony for each show day

Do not clean out your horse box/trailer on the field.

No horse or pony to be left unattended tied to a lorry or trailer

All classes will be run in accordance with the latest BRC official rules.

All horses must have had at least their first two vaccinations, and not have had a vaccine within 7 days of the show

Correctly fitted hard hats to CURRENT recognised British standard must be worn & securely fastened when mounted, And strongly recommended for In Hand. Anyone riding without a hat will be asked to leave the showground immediately without a refund for any classes they have entered.

Body protectors are strongly recommended.

In public areas of the show ground horses/ponies must be ridden/led at walk.

Please respect the hospitality of the landowners & take your litter home/use bins provided.

No refund of entry fees will be given.

The judge's decision is final & any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a £20 deposit, the deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.

Dogs must be kept on a short lead & under control at all times & all faeces picked up

Horses & ponies must not be left unattended unless correctly secured inside the trailer/lorry.

Age as of January 1st 2024

Any person riding on a lead rein must do so for the rest of the day.

Non-members riding a member's horse must pay non-members entry fees.

No horse/pony under 4 years of age can be ridden on the show ground.

No responsibility can be taken for theft, loss, damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

All persons attending must have their own 3rd party liability insurance.

Photographs: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst at this event: these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed, please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you start your round and when making your entry. The committee will also be taking photos during the day for our facebook page and website.

The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. Show Jumping (from 10.00am)

- Class 1 - 50cm including Lead Rein, Rosettes to all
- Class 2 - 60cm including Lead Rein, Rosettes to all
- Class 3 - 70cm
- Class 4 - 80cm
- Class 5 - 90cm

Eventer Challenge – A mix of showjumps and rustic fences. To run along side the showjumping and after the showjumping class of the same height.

- Class 6 - 60cm
- Class 7 - 70cm
- Class 8 - 80cm
- Class 9 - 90cm

In hand Showing (from 10.30am)

- Class 10 - Youngstock - For horses and ponies up to and including 3 years old
- Class 11 - Best Turned Out - Will split junior/senior if sufficient entries
- Class 12 - Intro to Showing - For novices never to have won an in hand showing class. Walk only, Can be assisted. This applies to horse, rider & combination.
- Class 13 - Young handler - Handler to be 14 and under – Hats to current BRC standards and gloves must be worn.
- Class 14 - Coloured - Including Appaloosa, Dun and Palomino
- Class 15 - Mountain & Moorland - Will split Large & Small if sufficient entries
- Class 16 - RoR - Horse must have raced/Been in training
- Class 17 - Veteran - Horses to be 15+ years,
- Class 18 - Best Mare/Gelding

In hand Championship for classes 6 to 14 - 1st & 2nd from each class

Ridden Showing (from 10.00am)

- Class 19 - Intro to Showing, Walk only- For novices never to have won a showing class. This applies to rider & combination.
- Class 20 - Intro to Showing, Walk & Trot - For novices not to have won 2 or more showing classes. This applies to rider & combination.
- Class 21 - Under 12s Lead Rein & First Ridden. Will split if sufficient entries
- Class 22 - Best Turned out – Rosette for best M&M
- Class 23 - Mountain and Moorland - Will split Large & Small if sufficient entries
- Class 24 - Best Mare/Gelding
- Class 25 - Riding Club Horse/Pony - Will split Junior/Senior if sufficient entries
- Class 26 - Coloured - Including Appaloosa, Dun and Palomino
- Class 27 - RoR - Horses must have raced/Been in training

Class 28 - Veteran - Horses to be 15+ years

Class 29 - Cobs and Cob type

Class 30 - Foreign Breeds, All breeds not native to the UK

Ridden Championship for classes 15 to 26 - 1st & 2nd from each class

Extra Rosettes for Showing

Highest placed M&M in the Best turned out classes

Highest placed over 20 in the Veteran horse classes

Highest placed HDRC Member in the Riding/Pony Club Horse class

Highest placed HDRC member in each Championship

Mini Show Jumping (from 10.30am)

Combinations jumping in this ring may not jump in the main showjumping. Lead rein & assistance permitted in all classes, Rosettes to all, No back rails.

- Class 31 - Poles on the floor
- Class 32 - 10cm – ½ X poles
- Class 33 - 20cm – X poles
- Class 34 - 30cm
- Class 35 - 40cm
- Class 36 - 50cm

Clear Round

Will be running alongside the Showjumping and mini jumping over a shortened course.

Riders must have paid First Aid & obtained a number.
