## **In-Hand Showing**

**9am Start April & July**

**Not before 11.30am May & September**

Class 1	Intro to Showing - For novices never to have won an in hand showing class. Walk only, Can be assisted. This applies to handler & combination
Class 2	Youngstock - For horses and ponies – Yearlings, 2 or 3 year olds
Class 3	Best Turned out
Class 4	Young handler - Handlers to have attained their 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday but not their 17 <sup>th</sup> before 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2026. Handlers pony should be a suitable size. Handlers can be accompanied by an adult in the ring, but the adult must not assist unless the handler is in difficulty - Hats to current BRC standards and gloves must be worn
Class 5	Veteran - Horses to be 15 years old and over
Class 6	Sport Horse & Retrained Racehorse.
Class 7	Coloured – Open to all coloured horses and ponies
Class 8	Mountain and Moorland – Open to all Breeds, Will Split Large & Small if entries permit
Class 9	Best Mare or Gelding
<b>Championship for all 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> &amp; 3<sup>rd</sup> from each class</b>	

## **Ridden Showing**

**9am Start May & September**

**Not before 11.30am April & July**

Class 10	Intro to Showing, Walk only- For novices never to have won a showing class. This applies to rider & combination.
Class 11	Intro to Showing, Walk & Trot - For novices not to have won 2 or more showing classes. This applies to rider & combination.
Class 12	Best Turned out - Open to any age, horse or pony. LR eligible for this class.
Class 13	Lead Rein Pony. Riders not to have attained their 12 <sup>th</sup> birthday before 1 <sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only
Class 14	Tiny Tots FR - walk & trot only - An excellent introduction to independent showing. Riders not to have attained their 12 <sup>th</sup> birthday before 1 <sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only
Class 15	First ridden - walk, trot & canter - Riders not to have attained their 12 <sup>th</sup> birthday before 1 <sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only
<b>We reserve the right to merge classes 13, 14 &amp; 15 if not sufficient entries</b>	
Class 16	Mountain and Moorland
Class 17	Coloured - Open to all coloured horses and ponies.
Class 18	Cobs - Open to all cobs, including traditional
Class 19	Riding Club Horse/Pony - Will split Junior/Senior if sufficient entries
Class 20	Sport Horse & Retrained Racehorse.
Class 21	Veteran - Horses to be 15 years old and over
Class 22	Best Mare or Gelding

## **Extra Rosettes for Ridden and In Hand Showing**

Highest placed M&M in the Best turned out classes

Highest placed over 20 in the Veteran horse classes

Highest placed HDRC Member in the Riding Club Horse/Pony class

Highest placed Ex racehorse in Sports Horse Class

Highest placed HDRC member in each Championship

**Ridden / In-hand SHOW classes;** 50% Type and Conformation: 50% Ride or Show, Manners and Way of Going

**Best Turned Out:** 30% Cleanliness, condition and correctness of tack: 30% Cleanliness and preparation of pony: 30% Cleanliness, neatness of rider (and handler if on LR) 10% overall impression.

## Rules & Conditions

**Maximum of 5 entries per Horse/Pony for each show day**

**Do not clean out your horse box/trailer on the parking area.**

**No horse or pony to be left unattended tied to a lorry or trailer**

All classes will be run in accordance with the latest BRC official rules.

All horses must have had at least their first two vaccinations, and not have had a vaccine within 7 days of the show

**Correctly** fitted hard hats to CURRENT recognised British standard must be worn & securely fastened when mounted and strongly recommended for In Hand. Anyone riding without a hat will be asked to leave the showground immediately without a refund for any classes they have entered.

**Body** protectors are strongly recommended.

**In public areas** of the show ground horses/ponies must be ridden/led at walk.

**Please** respect the hospitality of the landowners & take your litter home/use bins provided.

**The** judge's decision is final & any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a £20 deposit, the deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.

**No Dogs**

**Horses & ponies** must not be left unattended unless correctly secured inside the trailer/lorry.

**Age as of January 1st 2026**

**Any** person riding on a lead rein must do so for the rest of the day.

**Non-members** riding a member's horse must pay non-members entry fees.

**No** horse/pony under 4 years of age can be ridden on the show ground.

**No** responsibility can be taken for theft, loss, damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

**All** persons attending must have their own 3<sup>rd</sup> party liability insurance.

**Photographs:** by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst at this event: these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed, please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you start your round and when making your entry. The committee will also be taking photos during the day for our facebook page and website.

**The** organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present.
