Class 1	Intro to Showing - For novice riders never to have won an in hand showing class. Walk only, Can be assisted. This applies to handler & combination. ie experienced horse with novice rider or Novice combination
Class 2	Youngstock - For horses and ponies, Yearlings, 2 or 3 year olds
Class 3	Best Turned out
Class 4	Young handler - Handlers to have attained their 4 th birthday but not their 17 th before 1 st January 2026. Handlers pony should be a suitable size. Handlers can be accompanied by an adult in the ring, but the adult must not assist unless the handler is in difficulty - Hats to current BRC standards and gloves must be worn
Class 5	Veteran - Horses to be 15 years old and over
Class 6	Sport Horse, Hunter & Retrained Racehorse.
Class 7	Coloured – Open to all coloured horses and ponies Including Dun & Palamino
Class 8	Open Plaited horse/Pony – Open to all size of plaited horse/pony
Class 9	Mountain and Moorland – Open to all Breeds, Will Split Large & Small if entries permit
Class 10	Best Mare or Gelding
Class 11	Golden Oldies - Horse and Handler must have a combined age of 60 or over

Class 15	Intro to Showing, Walk only- For novices never to have won a showing class. This applies to rider & combination. ie experienced horse with novice rider or Novice combination
Class 16	Intro to Showing, Walk & Trot - For novices not to have won 2 or more showing classes. This applies to rider & combination. ie experienced horse with novice rider or Novice combination
Class 17	Best Turned out - Open to any age, horse or pony. LR eligible for this class.
Class 18	Lead Rein Pony. Riders not to have attained their 12 th birthday before 1 st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only
Class 19	Tiny Tots FR - walk & trot only - An excellent introduction to independent showing. Riders not to have attained their 12 th birthday before 1 st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only
Class 20	Family Horse/Pony. To be ridden by two members of the same family/two generations
Class 21	Mountain and Moorland - Open to all Breeds, Will Split Large & Small if entries permit
Class 22	Coloured - Open to all coloured horses and ponies. Including Dun & Palamino
Class 23	Cobs - Open to all cobs, including traditional
Class 24	Riding Club Horse/Pony - Will split Junior/Senior if sufficient entries
Class 25	Sport Horse, Hunter & Retrained Racehorse.
Class 26	Veteran - Horses to be 15 years old and over
Class 27	Best Mare or Gelding
Class 28	Golden Oldies - Horse and Rider must have a combined age of 60 or over
Class 29	Best Bitless – Must have two reins connected to the horses head. Walk around together and individual show at Walk and Trot. Canter optional. This class is NOT Bridleless

Rules & Conditions

Maximum of 5 entries per Horse/Pony for each show day

Do not clean out your horse box/trailer on the parking area.

No horse or pony to be left unattended tied to a lorry or trailer

All classes will be run in accordance with the latest BRC official rules.

All horses must have had at least their first two vaccinations, and not have had a vaccine within 7 days of the show

Correctly fitted hard hats to CURRENT recognised British standard must be worn & securely fastened when mounted and strongly recommended for In Hand. Anyone riding without a hat will be asked to leave the showground immediately without a refund for any classes they have entered.

Body protectors are strongly recommended.

In public areas of the show ground horses/ponies must be ridden/led at walk.

Please respect the hospitality of the landowners & take your litter home/use bins provided.

The judge's decision is final & any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a £20 deposit, the deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.

No Dogs

Horses & ponies must not be left unattended unless correctly secured inside the trailer/lorry.

Age as of January 1st 2026

Any person riding on a lead rein must do so for the rest of the day - unless Class 15 off lead rein.

Non-members riding a member's horse must pay non-members entry fees.

No horse/pony under 4 years of age can be ridden on the show ground.

No responsibility can be taken for theft, loss, damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

All persons attending must have their own 3rd party liability insurance.

Photographs: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst at this event: these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed, please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you start your round and when making your entry. The committee will also be taking photos during the day for our facebook page and website.
